Renewal Inspection: A renewal inspection was conducted during the morning and afternoon for the preschool and school-age children. The classrooms were set up with a wide range of open-ended materials for the children to engage in play. Invitations to play were arranged to welcome the children upon returning from outdoor play. Materials were stored on low, open shelves, making them easily accessible to the children and supporting independent choice and exploration. The children were observed participating in a variety of activities in the outdoor environments, including water and sand play, operating a car wash station, playing catch with their educators, and engaging in play with putty. Documentation was current and reflective of the children's past play experiences. Learning stories, children's artwork, and photos of the children were displayed in both the indoor and outdoor environments. The following records were reviewed: incident logs, fire drill records, professional learning hours, and daily attendance records. Child-to-staff ratios were observed to be in compliance throughout the renewal inspection. All required documentation was appropriately posted on the parent board. Diaper-changing and hand-washing routines were observed. All staff files were reviewed, and a selection of the children's files was also reviewed. The inspector discussed creating a book to record menu substitutions, ensuring all carpets are properly secured to the floor to reduce tripping hazards, and replacing the missing screw on the heater cover in Room 6 to ensure

it remains securely fastened. Five staff members require additional professional learning hours and will complete their remaining hours by August 31, 2026.

The facility is recommended for licensing.
