Comments: The safety straps on the change tables were observed to be broken and are no longer functioning as intended. The straps must be replaced to ensure children can be safely secured during diaper-changing routines and to reduce the risk of injury from falls. Until the straps are repaired or replaced, staff must ensure close supervision is maintained during all diaper-changing procedures.			

General Comments
Renewal Inspection A renewal inspection was conducted during the morning and afternoon for the infants and preschool children. The infants and preschool children were observed participating in a variety of activities, including sensory play, block play, reading with educators, playing with dinosaurs, and singing and dancing. All children were observed going outside, where they engaged in sand and water play, blew bubbles, rode cars, and participated in play experiences with their educators. Documentation was current and reflective of the children's past play experiences. Learning stories, children's artwork, and photos of the children were displayed in both the indoor and outdoor environments. The following records were reviewed: incident logs, fire drill records, infant/toddler daily sheets, professional learning hours, and daily attendance records. Child-to-staff ratios were observed to be in compliance throughout the renewal inspection. All required documentation was appropriately posted on the parent board. Diaper-changing and hand-washing routines were observed. All staff files were reviewed, and a selection of the children's files was also reviewed.

General Comments

The inspector discussed creating a book to document menu substitutions and ensuring that the foot stools are cleaned after messy play activities.
