Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that a new staff member didn't have any CPR certification. Administrators and educators must hold a valid first-aid certificate and a valid CPR certificate. The staff in question is registered to complete their CPR certification on December 2nd. The staff in question can never be left alone with the children until they obtain their certification.

Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed in a new staff member's file that a valid CPR certification was missing. All staff files must contain a copy of a valid first aid certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate. The Educator is enrolled on December 2nd to complete their CPR certification, a copy of registration is in the staff file. The staff in question can never be left alone with the children until her certification.

Comments: In two different classrooms, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a container of Accel Intervention Wipes that was not locked. Toxic products, chemical products, and cleaning supplies must be locked and inaccessible to children. The educators locked the disinfecting wipes per the Quality Assurance Monitor's request. Deficiency is now compliant.</p> <p>In another classroom, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed 3 lunch boxes that were not labelled with the name of the child. Food brought from home must be labelled with the names of the children. The educator labelled the lunch boxes with the name of the child during the inspection.</p>			

General Comments
<p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the morning to conduct a monitoring inspection. The ratio was respected during the inspection.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following elements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Washroom - Diaper changing - Personal belonging - Nutrition - Indoor play area and equipment <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding designation requirements. The administrator confirmed that the Quality Improvement Plan is current, and all eligible educators are actively completing their required 10 hours of professional learning per renewal year.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor observed a group of children playing in the outdoor play area after having their morning snack outside. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed the children eating their morning snack inside. The children then transitioned to the indoor play area for free play, drawing, and sensory play. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.</p>
