The Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following elements:

- Washroom
- Diaper changing
- Personal belonging
- Nutrition
- Indoor play area and equipment

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding designation requirements. The administrator confirmed that the Quality Improvement Plan is current, and all eligible educators are actively completing their required 10 hours of professional learning per renewal year.

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed a group of children playing in the outdoor play area after having their morning snack outside. The Quality Assurance Monitor also observed the children eating their morning snack inside. The children then transitioned to the indoor play area for free play, drawing, and sensory play. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.
