<p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities outdoors this morning including sprinkler play, gross motor play and building with blocks.</p> <p>The indoor play area appears to be well maintained and organized. QA Monitor discussed setting up invitations throughout the environments for children to explore at arrival and when they come indoors. QA Monitor left some ideas/examples of how this could look with administrator on site.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through documentation displayed throughout the learning environment that supports the children's current interests (music and movement and performing shows and concerts). Each child's learning and experiences are documented in their individual portfolios.</p>
