Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed in one classroom 1 bottle of water not labelled. Personal belongings must be labelled with the name of the child. The educator labelled the bottle of water during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor observed in a classroom 2 lunch boxes that were not labelled with the names of the children. Food brought from home must be labelled with the names of the children. The educator labelled the lunch boxes with the names of the children during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant.

<p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the morning to conduct a monitoring inspection. The ratio was respected during the inspection.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following elements:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Washroom</li> <li>- Diaper changing</li> <li>- Personal belonging</li> <li>- Nutrition</li> <li>- Indoor play area and equipment</li> </ul> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding designation requirements. The administrator confirmed that the Quality Improvement Plan is current, and all eligible educators are actively completing their required 10 hours of professional learning per renewal year.</p>

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed a group of children playing in the outdoor play area after having their morning snack outside. The children then transitioned to the indoor play area for free play, drawing, and sensory play. Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.
