## **General Comments**

A Monitoring Inspection occurred on April 2, 2025.

Children were observed during indoor free play and snack time. Proper handwashing practices were followed during snack and the transition indoors. Steps or platforms were available to ensure children could safely access regular-sized toilets and sinks.

Educators noted that children are currently highly engaged in outdoor activities, individual and group art projects, and exploring different materials. During the inspection, children and educators were observed creating and colouring paper umbrellas. Foam clay magnets, previously made by the children, were displayed in the room. Educators engaged in meaningful conversations with the children, asking questions and expanding on the ideas presented by them.

The daily incident log is maintained, and parents are informed of any incidents. Evacuation procedures are clearly posted in a prominent location. The room setup is inviting, with materials intentionally arranged to encourage play. Books reflecting the children's interests were available. Well-defined learning and play areas were observed, and children's artwork was displayed throughout the facility. All toxic products, including cleaning supplies, were locked and inaccessible to children. Drinking water was provided throughout the day.

Daily activities are purposefully planned, offering opportunities for both individual and group experiences. Various forms of children's artwork were observed throughout the facility. A conversation took place with Administrators regarding the strengths and areas for improvement in the facility. Strengths identified include the presence of various forms of literacy and art in the indoor environment. However, areas needing attention were also noted, including peeling paint in the downstairs bathroom, which will require repainting and wall repairs as needed.
