General Comments

Upon arrival to the facility, the children engage in free choices throughout the room. There are many learning centres set up with a variety of materials. This includes but is not limited to a block centre, building materials, a doll house, cars, a kitchen and dramatic play area, puzzles, Lego and Art materials.

The children washed their hands and have a snack that is brought from home. After snack, the children sat and listened to a story called "I ain't going to paint no more". They moved from the cozy book area to the tables where water paint was set up for the children.

The children enjoyed some time in the school playground. The playground has swings and climbing structures. It also has a mud kitchen that the children can use. The children did have access to a few dump trucks while playing outside. One of the educators stated that they have a bin with some materials in it. As you move forward into the Fall, plan to set up learning centres as an extension of the indoor play environment. For example, books, art materials, kitchen accessories, etc.

The educators are demonstrating how they are programming by the interests of the children. Webbing is kept on file and it clearly shows how the children's interests grow through main topics. A calendar is given to the parent(s) and learning stories and portfolios are being used to capture the children's learning.

Many of the preschool children leave at noon and the school age children arrive. They washed their hands upon arrival and then had a choice to eat snack or play. The time for the school age children is more unstructured as they spend a large portion of their day in the school environment. The educators state that they spend a large amount of time outside after they arrive. The school age children arrived closer to 3pm.

Fire drills and incident records are being completed. One of the educators did say that they have not had to use any potential illness forms but the facility does have them in the event that they have to use them. Staff and Child files were organized and complete. All documentation was easily verified for licensing purposes.
