The operator must ensure that a copy of a valid first aid (FA) certificate and a valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate is maintained in the educator's file.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the staff signed statement regarding obligations under the Act and licensing regulation is missing in 4 of the 11 staff files audited. The operator must ensure that a signed copy of the statement regarding obligations under the Act and licensing regulation is maintained in the educator's file.

These consent forms should outline the date, time of departure and return, destination and purpose of trip, any special considerations and the parents /guardian's signature.
