Comments: During the review of staff files, the following concerns regarding First Aid and CPR certification were noted: one staff file, the First Aid and CPR certificate was found to be expired. In another file, the photocopy of the certificate did not display the provider's logo. To confirm whether the training was completed through a recognized WorkSafeNB provider, an additional copy was requested for verification. The administrator was able to provide a photo of the certificate, which displayed the provider's logo. However, upon review, the Quality Assurance Monitor determined that the certificate was not issued by a provider recognized by WorkSafeNB.								
The staff member in question must obtain a valid First Aid and CPR certificate from a recognized WorkSafeNB provider or provide written confirmation from WorkSafeNB that the current certificate is recognized or exempt. It is the operator's responsibility to ensure that any staff member without a valid First Aid and CPR certificate

The Quality Assurance Monitor was on site to conduct the renewal inspection.

Staff-to-child ratios were in compliance at the time of the visit. During the inspection, children were observed eating snack, participating in indoor play, and transitioning to outdoor play to conclude the day.

reminding children of the rules, engaging in reflective conversations to help them understand the consequences of their actions and words, and redirecting their attention away from potential issues.

The Quality Assurance Monitor discussed the importance of positive child guidance with the administrator, so she can support the staff. It is strongly recommended that all staff review Section 8.2 of the Operator's

A discussion was held with the administrator regarding the outdoor play area. The designated outdoor play area for the school-age children is a municipal park located approximately 700 meters from the premises. As the outdoor play area is off-site, it was not inspected during the renewal inspection.

It is the operator's responsibility to ensure that the outdoor play area is safe for children. Any safety concerns identified must be promptly communicated to the city to ensure appropriate corrective action is taken.

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed that, in the absence of the administrator, the group of children appeared to be difficult to manage. While one staff member was occupied with cleaning tasks, the other staff member struggled to maintain control and engagement with the group.

To ensure adequate supervision and promote a safe, staff members must remain actively engaged with the
