During the monitoring inspection there were long cords for electronics and items stacked high on a desk in the indoor play area. Cords for blinds were also hanging low and were accessible to children. The operator was able to remove items from the desk and secure all cords.

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General Comments

Regular monitoring visit performed on this date. Operator has moved into basement as the new indoor play space and napping area. Indoor play area was clean and bright. Materials were developmentally appropriate and provided a variety of play based experiences. Bathroom, changing table and extra sink were also available in this area. All required documents were posted on the parent board with updated information in regard to the changed space.

Operator has been using large indoor play pen to aid in caring for infant twins within the same play space as the older children in attendance. Licensing staff supported this layout for its practical use and safety while feeding infants.

Licensing staff will continue to support operator transitioning to new indoor play space and in reestablishing documentation of children's learning.
