General Comments

- Mid-morning visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection
- Ratio was respected during the visit
- No medicine is kept on site
- Daily routine into the center includes; Outdoor play time at least once every 4 hour blocks time when the weather is permitting. Meal and snacks are served at the recognized hours and a daily rest period that meets the children's needs.
- Toxic products, and cleaning supplies are locked under key and are inaccessible to children
- It was observed during the visit that when in a situation of misunderstanding, children's guidance is done by reflecting emotions, guidance is provided towards problem solving to allow children to find a solution
- Within the home base setting the front room of the house is designated for nap time. One infant is napping in a room upstairs which has been checked by the fire Marshall and meets all standards. Each child has a designated cot or a playpen (0-23months). The operator confirms that the sheets and blankets are washed weekly by herself weekly
- A diaper pad covered with a non-absorbent layer is used to change diapers. Diaper changing is done in the washroom upstairs which is less than a one meter from a sink and is separate from food preparation area. Children are always supervised during diaper change.
- Diaper changing necessities are stored separately and easy to access for each child that is not potty trained

Observations: When arriving at the center children were coming in from outside, they all washed their hands and ate their lunch. Once they were done eating, the operator gathers all the children (1 infant and her own) they went upstairs for their nap, one child slept in the front room while the other stayed up with the operator. Checks are being done every 15min on the children sleeping.
