<p>General Comments</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Mid-day visit to the establishment for an unexpected monitoring inspection -Ratio was respected in all groups during the visit -The operator as well as all educators have a valid first aid certificate -The operator has her Early Childhood Education certificate -When acetaminophen is administered to a child, the consent form is signed by the parent and kept into the children file. -Administration of medication records are evident -Medications are locked in the kitchen and inaccessible to children -Daily routine into the center includes; Outdoor play time at least once every 4-hour blocks time when the weather is permitting. Meal and snacks are served at the recognized hours and a daily rest period that meets the children's needs. -During the visit, it was observed that all educators are engaged with children at their level providing support and having conversations. Open-end questions are asked and guidance is given in a respectful and kind way -Outdoor play area is maintained safe and free of hazards -In the outdoor play area children have more than one type of surfacing to play and explore, the material offered is varied and in sufficient quantity for children present -A first-aid kit and a phone are always accessible on site and on outings. -Each child has an easily accessible space to store their personal belongings, which is labeled with their name and used only for the intended child. <p>Observations: When arriving at the center two children out of three were having a rest period, when getting up they all played with the Play-Doh and were talking about what to have for a snack.</p>
