General Comments								

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct a monitoring inspection visit on July 4th, 2022.

Licensing staff and the Administrator were discussing the school-aged classroom and how to plan purposely planned activities to keep the children engaged while attending the centre during the summer months. Licensing staff recommended referencing the NB Playbook- A Resource for Quality After School Programming.

The school-aged children have a lovely and very large outdoor play space which includes a wooded area that the children were exploring in for a majority of the inspection visit.

All educators were observed engaged with the children the entire inspection visit.

All cleaning supplies and medications were locked up in a cabinet with a lock and key.

Licensing staff observed positive child guidance techniques being used by the educatorsused, such as, redirection and diversion, to redirect undesired behaviours.
