The operator has decided to stop serving snacks and parent's provide all snacks now. The operator has sent a change in service for this and parents received notice for this change.				
During my monitoring visit, the operator had a new infant arrive for their first full day at childcare. The operator allowed for a smooth transition for the parent and infant and provided lots of nurturing care- holding the infant, speaking softly to him, and showing him different toys. She also read many stories to the children before lunch and all children liked this.				
All non-compliances from the previous visit have been addressed. Both the kitchen and bathroom were very clean and the transition trim between the two rooms has been repaired. The missing documents and information from the child files has been added and are complete.
