<p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a follow-up inspection. Ratio was respected during the visit.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor was able to observe children playing indoor and some children were making pink shirt craft. The Quality Assurance Monitor was also able to observe children eating lunch and transition to nap time.</p> <p>During lunch time the Quality Assurance Monitor noticed that the educators heat up the children's lunches and at one point and educator went to cut and peel an apple. The Quality Assurance Monitor asked the administrator if the facility had a license to handle food. The administrator was not sure but the administrator was able to confirm that some educators do have a food handling course. The Quality Assurance Monitor told the administrator that they should consult with public health to see if they need a food license. The Quality Assurance Monitor will also be in contact with public health in regards to this matter.</p>
