In order to ensure that each child's needs are met, the operator must ensure that they have access to a cot. The inspector asked whether cots were available for the child, and immediately a cot was offered to the child. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: The inspector observed 2 containers of Lysol Wipes and a Lysol All-Purpose spray cleaner in a cabinet inside the bathroom of an infant classroom. In classrooms 3A and B, the inspector observed 2 bottles of Febreze Air Freshener, 1 can of shaving cream and 2 bottles of Scentsy Spray freshener not locked. While on site, the inspector discussed the location of the toxic products with educators and administrators.

Comments: The inspector observed 6 awake infants in the napping room with one educator, while the other educator was mopping the classroom floor. The inspector reminded both educators that child-to-staff ratio must be maintained at all times. The educator promptly went into the napping room to ensure the ratio. Deficiency is now compliant
