General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct a monitoring inspection.
The child-to-staff ratio was maintained throughout the visit.

During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor verified the following:

Required postings were displayed in a visible and prominent location within the facility.

Indoor play area materials and equipment were present and appropriate.

While on site, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed children freely engaging in outdoor play and transitioning smoothly from outdoor to indoor activities in preparation for lunch.

A discussion took place between the educators and the Quality Assurance Monitor regarding the shelving unit dividing one of the infant rooms into two sections. The Quality Assurance Monitor informed the educators that the fire marshal had previously indicated the need for a clear passage through the shelving in case of emergency, as the exit that leads directly outdoors are on the other side of the shelving's. Educators expressed challenges in keeping children on their designated side of the room. The Quality Assurance Monitor also brought the matter to the attention of the on-site administrator, who promptly entered the room and adjusted the shelving to allow for a proper passageway.

Another discussion was held regarding the accessibility of art materials. The Quality Assurance Monitor noted that while art supplies were visible and available in classrooms, they were not within reach of the children. Educators were advised to reposition the materials lower on the shelves to ensure accessibility.
