The administrator sent via email copies of the professional learning hours, but those hours will only count for the next licensing year.

Comments: The inspector observed in 1 out of 8 child files verified is missing an emergency contact. The administrator must ensure that each child has 2 emergency contacts.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (a) labelled with the name of the child.	40(1)(a)	Apr 09, 2025	
Comments: The inspector observed that 1 water bottle out of 10 verified is not labelled. The administrator must ensure that all the personal belongings of the children are labelled.
