Only 11 children were marked present, while 14 children were in attendance. The Quality Assurance Monitor brought this to the educator's attention, and the attendance sheet was updated immediately. Deficiency is now compliant.

During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed various parts of the daily routine, including children eating snack, engaging in free indoor play, preparing for outdoor play, playing outside, having lunch, and resting during nap time.

A discussion was held with the administrator regarding the outdoor play area. The Quality Assurance Monitor noted that the sand around the swing and at the bottom of the slide needed to be raked. The administrator responded that additional sand would be added in the coming weeks and that the area would be raked in the meantime. The Quality Assurance Monitor also suggested adding more toys and materials to the outdoor space. The administrator confirmed that they are currently in the process of enhancing the outdoor play area with additional materials.
