Comments: When the Quality Assurance Monitor asked a staff member how many children were present, the staff member stated there were 10 children, noting that one child was in the washroom with the Inclusion Support Worker. A few minutes later, the Inclusion Support Worker returned to the classroom with the child. At that point, the Quality Assurance Monitor discussed with both staff members the importance of ensuring that Inclusion Support Workers are not included in the child-to-staff ratio and reiterated that they must not be left alone with					
children under any circumstances. Deficiency is now compliant.					

General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor conducted a follow-up inspection on-site.

During the visit, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed children engaged in indoor activities, including napping, and playing.

General Comments

A discussion ensued between the Quality Assurance Monitor and the administrator concerning the child-to-staff ratio when Inclusion Support Workers are present. The Quality Assurance monitor emphasized that Inclusion Support Workers are not counted toward the child-to-staff ratio and reminded the administrator that they should never be left alone with children.
