Comments: During lunch, an educator responsible for a mixed-age group of seven children allowed two children to leave the classroom to use the bathroom without supervision. If the educator is unable to accompany children to the bathroom, they must ensure that another staff member is informed and available to supervise either the children using the bathroom or the remaining group. This ensures that all children are adequately supervised at all times. After a few minutes, the educator realized that the supervision was not adequate and asked the remaining group to join her so she could properly supervise the two children in the washroom. Deficiency is now compliant			
9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.	9(1)	Sep 24, 2025	Sep 24, 2025
Comments: During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed one educator alone with six infants while the other educator was preparing lunch for all children at the facility. The administrator explained that normally an additional staff member is on site to assist during lunch preparation; however, this was not the case on the day of the inspection. As a result, the child-to-staff ratio was not maintained in the same age group, for approximately 15 minutes. It is important to note that the child-to-staff ratio must be respected at all times to ensure the safety and well-being of the children. Once the educator returned to her class, the ratio returned to 2:6. Deficiency is now compliant

During the inspection, children play indoors, outdoors and eat lunch.
