This ensures that all children are adequately supervised at all times. After a few minutes, the educator realized that the supervision was not adequate and asked the remaining group to join her so she could properly supervise the two children in the washroom.

During the monitoring inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed one educator alone with six infants while the other educator was preparing lunch for all children at the facility. The administrator explained that normally an additional staff member is on site to assist during lunch preparation; however, this was not the case on the day of the inspection. As a result, the child-to-staff ratio was not maintained in the same age group, for approximately 15 minutes. It is important to note that the child-to-staff ratio must be respected at all times to ensure the safety and well-being of the children. Once the educator returned to her class, the ratio returned to 2:6. Deficiency is now compliant
