General Comments						
Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the children were sitting at a table with the Operator eating morning snack. The Operator was engaged in conversations with the children and asking if their bellies were full or if they wanted more snacks. As the children finished snack, they picked a book to read while their peers finished eating. Once all children had finished the Operator suggested to the children to use the bathroom before walking to the park. The Operator was observed offering assistance with zippering jackets and putting outdoor shoes on. A final headcount was observed before leaving the facility. At the park the children joined another group to sing songs and read a book with Talk with Me. Once the program was finished, the children made their way to the playground where they were seen scooping rocks into buckets, swinging on the swing set and playing with a stomp rocket. The Operator was attentive to their needs while playing outside with them, wiping noses and giving hugs. When it was time for lunch, the children helped clean up the toys and were seen cleaning their hands before sitting on a picnic blanket to eat. After lunch the children walked back to the facility. Proper diaper changing procedures were observed before the children settled on their cots for quiet time. Documentation has been added since the last Monitoring Visit. Webbing was posted on the walls and crafts were observed. A discussion was had with the Operator on how to build on this, as per the New Brunswick Curriculum for Early Learning and Childcare, it is encouraged to include additional photos of the children engaged in the activities and have it posted at their level. The Parent board has also been fixed since the last Monitoring Visit. As a reminder, plug in air fresheners are considered a toxic product, therefore not permitted.
