General Comments

This is the first monitoring inspection since this facility became licensed.

When I arrived for the monitoring visit, I was greeted by the camp supervisor and senior leader. I was introduced to all staff by the program director.

During the first part of the morning, the children were having free time on the mats. Children were observed talking with their friends and playing tag. There is lots of space to run, play tag and other gross motor games on the mats.

The children were divided into two groups- the red group and the green group and the routine runs smoothly with the climbing walls and tables/benches.

It was noted that no other materials or resources were available to the children during the first two hours of the visit. At one point there was some paper and a bin of markers and pencil crayons set out. There must be other choices made available to the children throughout the entire morning. Examples for this group could be bracelet making, coloring, cards, board games, or Lego. If children are finishing up snack and waiting for others, they need other activities available besides free play on the mat or playing tag. I observed some children waiting several minutes to begin their orientation to climbing since they had finished their snack first. After a long period of climbing, one group had the choices of continued climbing or X Tag.

I also noted that none of the required postings were in a visible, prominent place for parents, staff and other Page 2 of 3

people entering the facility to see. Please ensure you have a bulletin board permanently displayed for this purpose or a moveable one that is brought into the space and displayed during operating hours.

Staff and child files were well organized. In the child files, the child profile form did not have the pages that include consents.

Child guidance was good and I heard lots of positive comments, patience and the leaders show enthusiasm to teach the children about bouldering.

The program director is updating the staff contract. I was shown the updated version. Please include this in all staff files and include the staff handbook page that staff members also sign.

Attendance records are being used but incorrectly. The time the children arrive must be indicated along with the departure time.
