General Comments

Observed outdoor play at Connaught Playground. Educators remained engaged with children- playing games and helping with snacks. A large wagon was used to transport a water jug, paper cups, first aid bags and other supplies. Children had a number of basketballs to play with as well.

Flexibility was offered with snack time and children could return to the gazebo area to eat as they were hungry.

Multiple washroom breaks were incorporated into the routine to have educators bring children back to the centre. Please ensure that an educator who is remaining at the playground, stands by the gate when the group has left for the washroom to provide enhanced supervision at the gate. Also, reminding children of this part of the routine and transition- especially younger children and children who are new to Fredericton Bouldering Co-op.

Strong child guidance practices were observed with educators speaking to children on their level and providing choices. Educators consistently used a low, respectful tone with the children. Communication among the team was also observed.

Upon returning to the centre, children were reminded to wash hands and have a drink of water. Children had climbing time and the administrator provided a lot of encouraging words.

The indoor play materials have been organized and a new shelf used to provide easy access. Mark making materials were also accessible to children.

Pending a current fire inspection, I recommend for renewal
