Comments: Deficiency is now compliant While observing the children during morning snack time, the operator left the eating area to retrieve additional snacks for the children and in doing so, the children were left unsupervised for a very short time period. Licensing staff recommends that the operator collect all snack/lunch items before the children sit down to eat in order to supervise the children at all times while they are eating.			

<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>Licensing staff arrived at the licensed early learning and childcare home to conduct the annual license renewal inspection.</p> <p>The children were engaging in free play activities before engaging in a story time. The operator incorporated plastic animals while reading "Peppa Pig." licensing staff heard the operator asking open ended questions about the book while reading to the children.</p> <p>The operator followed the lead of the children and provided additional materials to the children to extend the learning that was occurring.</p> <p>The indoor learning environment was very clean and inviting and had an abundance of evidence of learning posted on the wall and displayed on tables.</p> <p>On the day of the inspection, the operator gave the children a fruit pouch, milk and a cookie for snack and at lunch time the operator prepared chickpea pancakes for lunch with grapes, blueberries and water to drink.</p> <p>The operator guided the children positively and was compassionate towards the children when they were sad.</p>
