Comments: A photo was received by email showing a distinct play center with science material. On site inspection of September 24, 2025, confirmed.  Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: The storage shelf in the infant room has been re-organized, and no material or supplies were noted to be on the top level of the shelf. Please continue to ensure that material and additional supplies are stored in a safe manner.  Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: The siding and deep holes in the ground in the preschool / school age play space have been repaired.  During the inspection, licensing staff checked the fence, and it was sturdy with sharp edges turned away. An email was received confirming that the fence is scheduled to be replaced to match the black chain link fencing before winter weather and snow. Please provide photos once permanent fence has been added.  Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Shade sails and umbrellas were in place.  Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Indoor play material was organized in defined stations in each classroom as well as the gym play area. There were accessible bins of loose play pieces as well as open-ended material. Science, art, literacy, music, and dramatic play materials were readily available.  Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: In the preschool/school age space outdoor play material such as painted tires, a mud kitchen with bins of kitchen pans, large blocks, a pea gravel construction digging site, Little Tikes cars, balls, and a stand-up sand box with accessories were in good condition.  In the infant outdoor space, play material such as two playhouses, painted tires, balls, a wooden platform with steering wheel and Little Tikes chairs and teeter-totter were in good condition.  Deficiency is now compliant			
49(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that the guidance of the children receiving services at the licensed facility is positive and includes positive reinforcement, encouraging efforts and recognizing accomplishments.	49(1)	Jun 03, 2025	Sep 24, 2025
Comments: During inspection, a discussion occurred with the site Administrator. It was noted that the tone of voice had been addressed with the Educator. Educators from each classroom were observed during the inspection and observed to be engaged with the children in outdoor play as well as indoors in the infant room. Only positive child guidance was observed.  Deficiency is now compliant			

General Comments
<p>Licensing staff arrived to complete the renewal inspection. Upon arrival, the preschool age children were playing outdoors while the infants were indoors.</p> <p>The preschool age children were observed playing with colourful plastic building blocks, digging with small cups and scoops at the stand-up sand box and trucks in the pea gravel. Water bottles were observed to be outdoors as well as the daily attendance record form. Educators were engaged in conversation and play with the children outdoors. The infant outdoor play space was secured with a fence and gate. Play material was in good condition and shade sails and umbrellas were in place. Please have the grass mowed.</p> <p>While indoors, the infants age group was observed singing songs and dancing. Current webbing and learning stories were posted and play material such as soft cubes, play tools, dolls and sensory material were accessible and in good condition. Diaper changing procedures were observed and daily attendance records were in order.</p> <p>It is recommended in the 3-year-old classroom the coat rack be removed and hooks for coats and lunch bags be added to the wall to allow a more organized personal belongings space. Also, it is recommended that the white storage cupboard be removed from the gym play space as it was becoming overloaded with material and supplies on the top.</p> <p>Licensing staff recommends for renewal pending Fire and Health Inspection.</p>
