General Comments
<p>Children were in the outdoor play space when I arrived. They were engaged in a variety of activities such as chopping up chunks of ice, playing with trucks in the rock corner, balancing on tires, playing in the mud kitchen and driving l'il tykes cars.</p> <p>The educators are documenting the children's learning through learning stories, webbing and journaling. It is recommended that each room goes through their books and repair or replace the ones that are worn out and have ripped pages.</p> <p>Children are familiar with the lunch time routine of washing hands, eating lunch, going to their nap cot or playing with quiet materials.</p> <p>Public health completed an inspection on September 25, 2025. As per the report " duct tape on the moldings along the floor must be removed and moldings must be repaired. All moldings that are missing must be replaced." To date, this has not been completed.</p> <p>Upon arrival, there were narrow blanks being used as a walkway at the main entrance as there is a lower area that floods and builds up with ice during the colder months. A proper step or walkway needs to be constructed.</p>
