The educator set out a painting activity and children were invited to participate if they wanted but the educator also set out Lego and the children were very interested in that. Other children had the option to play soccer.

Both the educator and Inclusion Support Worker remained engaged with the children and asked them lots of questions to continue developing a strong rapport with them. They asked about sports, their day at school, weekend plans. Reminders were given in a friendly and respectful tone.

The walls have a few different hockey logos and other environmental print that are of interest for this group.

As a reminder, as enrollment increases for summer, continue adding more materials to the space.
