A renewal inspection occurred today. Children were observed over their snacks and lunch. Children were observed in both indoor and outdoor environments. Documentation was present, representing children's current interest and curiosities(including "how tall are our pumpkins". Indoor props were child-size , inviting, comfortable and accessible.

Educators were observed during transition periods, using songs (such as " baby bumblebee") and games to have transitions run effectively.

Invitations were set up in each learning environment that welcomed children to free play and engagement of all senses.

All staff files were observed and complete. A random review of children's files were observed and missing one emergency contact. Admin will add when received.

All checks were observed and complete. Parent board was also up to date and admin will add inspectors phone number along with the address currently there.
