Monitoring Inspection:

Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including mark making, openended art, playdoh, dramatic play, and fine motor activities. Each learning environment is set-up with a variety of invitations for the children to explore freely.

In the Three/Fours Room a small group of children were observed making playdoh with their educators. Children were encouraged to take turns with materials and to problem solve by using their words during this activity. Educators were observed using positive child guidance techniques.

A small group of infants were observed engaging in mark making with their educator. The children were exploring different mark making materials and were also exploring stacking, dumping and matching the covers to the markers. The educator added words to their play and encouraged them to explore the materials freely.
