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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>Children and educators observed engaged in a variety of activities this morning including mark making, stories, sensory opportunities, fine motor activities, and gross motor activities. The infants were observed exploring age-appropriate mark making materials with their educator. The children in Twos Room were participating in a dance party and exploring open ended art materials. The children in the 2/3 Room were observed filling and pouring water at the sensory table and exploring fine motor and gross motor materials. A small group of children from the Fours Room were observed building with magnetic tiles and playing hopscotch in the hallway. The rest of the group was observed painting with feathers in the learning environment with their educators.</p> <p>Purposeful planning is evident through invitations, documentation and materials added to the environments that support the children's current interests (animals, firefighters, vehicles, babies, bugs, and building). Each learning environment has a variety of play materials displayed on low open shelving for the children to explore freely.</p> <p>Educators were observed conducting frequent headcounts of children during staff transitions. Educators communicated the number of children present with each other as they relieved each other for breaks.</p> <p>The children did not participate in outdoor play this morning due to the windchill however, staff were watching the forecast and planning to go outside in the afternoon. Each room has gross motor equipment to encourage big body movements throughout the day.</p> <p>The site supervisor was observed to be checking in with staff throughout the morning and stepping in to help during transition times and supporting where needed.</p> <p>Boiled eggs and toast with jam were served for morning snack. Soup and sandwiches were served for lunch. Handwashing routines were observed during washroom routines and before mealtimes. Monthly fire drills are documented.</p> <p>Daily attendance records are accurate and reflect all children present. Child-to-staff ratio was observed to be</p>
