A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. Children were observed inside. Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility. Today's snack was rice cakes and nut butter. Educators were engaged with the children. Educators were observed talking to the children, taking part in children's play, and reading to the children. Infants - The infants were out for a walk at QAM's arrival. 2/3 Group - QAM observed the 2/3 group returning inside, from outside play. Children were observed washing their hands, before snack. Children introduced QAM to Tucker the Turtle. Tucker is a turtle that helps children with self-regulation. There was an area on the wall dedicated to Tucker, and this area included information on self-regulation techniques, feelings, and breathing exercises. 3/4 Group - Children were observed during free play time. Children were observed playing with babies, drawing / coloring, and playing with trucks. Morning preschool - Children were observed washing their hands before snack. Children were observed getting ready for outside play. A conversation was had with administrator regarding children who are not feeling well. As stated in Appendix 14 – Managing Illness in ELC Facilities – Parent's / Guardian's Role, it states the following: If a child is too sick to participate comfortably in activities and has symptoms or a condition that may affect the health of other children, it is necessary that the child not attend childcare.
