General Comments							
A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. Children were observed inside. The 3/4 group were observed making Easter Bunny masks, and playing with colored rings - catching, throwing, and rolling them, with their friends. The 2/3 group were observed building with their new foam bricks. Children were excited to show off their new bricks. Several examples of open-ended art were observed. The 2's group were observed coloring and eating snack. The infants were observed sitting on the floor, with their educators, building Lego and exploring the play kitchen / kitchen accessories. Children were served strawberries, grapes, and crackers for their morning snack. Positive Child Guidance Techniques were observed – educators sitting with the children, taking part in activities, providing choices, and using positive language. Several forms of documentation were observed throughout the facility. Educators were observed setting up an Easter Egg Hunt, and the children were excited for the Easter Bunnies arrival. A conversation was had with administrator regarding the snack menu. The snack menu is to reflect what the children are being served. When changes are made, changes are to appear on the white boards, at the front of each room, so parents are aware. Any changes are also to appear on the snack menus in each room, and on the main menu, in the kitchen, on the fridge. Menus, showing all changes, are to be kept in a file. Updated
