A Monitoring Inspection was completed this afternoon. Quality Assurance Monitors Cathleen LeBlanc and Robyn Nelson completed the inspection. Infants -Children were observed sitting at a table with their educators, taking part in a painting activity. A conversation was had with administrator regarding the chipped paint, on the lower section of the walls.								
Administrator was aware and was in the process of figuring out a plan.								

2's Room - Children were observed sitting at a table, with their educator, completing Arts & Crafts. Children were observed using crayons, stickers, buttons, and glue. A conversation was had with educator regarding small parts, and how children must be supervised at all times, when utilizing them. Educator was observed giving proper supervision.

2/3 Room - Children were observed during outside play. New additions have been added to the outdoor, fenced in play area. A big red jeep, a mud kitchen, and a new sunshade were some of the newly added additions.

3/4 Room - Children were observed during inside play. Children were observed playing with bugs, babies, and puzzles. Children were also observed sliding and climbing on their new indoor gross motor play structure.

School Aged Room - Children in the school aged program were present all day today, due to a Professional

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Development Day, in the schools. Children were observed playing with Play Doh, finishing up a pizza craft, and getting ready for an afternoon movie. A conversation was had with educator regarding the coloring sheets that were on the wall. Coloring sheets are ok for school aged, but open-ended art / blank paper, is recommended.
