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<p>General Comments</p> <p>Monitoring Inspection:</p> <p>A monitoring inspection was conducted today during both the morning and afternoon. Observations took place in the 2/3-year-old room and the 4-year-old room.</p> <p>The 2/3-year-old room was observed during free play. The educator shared with licensing staff that the children had just completed a bubble wrap painting activity. The children were engaged in a variety of activities including coloring, playing with toy animals, constructing a pirate ship using chairs, and having snack. The educators were observed supporting play and engaging positively with the children.</p> <p>Outdoor play was also observed, where the children were jumping in puddles, digging in the sand, and interacting with educators during play.</p> <p>The 4-year-old room was observed participating in a painting activity where the children painted planting pots. Following this activity, the group went for a walk around the neighborhood and then spent time in the outdoor play area. While outside, the children were observed splashing in puddles, playing with toy cars, and engaging in sand play.</p> <p>Upon returning indoors, the children were offered the opportunity to participate in another painting activity. The children were given choices regarding the color of construction paper they wished to use and used forks as paint brushes.</p> <p>The documentation in both rooms was current and reflective of the children's learning. The educators were observed demonstrating positive interactions with the children, validating their feelings when they became upset, actively engaging in play, and offering choices throughout the day. Transitions in both rooms were smooth and well managed. The educators were observed counting the children and cross-checking numbers with the Government Attendance Records.</p>
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General Comments

One new staff file was reviewed during the inspection, and all required documentation was in place. Hand washing and diaper changing procedures were observed and followed appropriately. Government Attendance Records and incident logs were reviewed and found to be up to date.
