## General Comments

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site to conduct a monitoring inspection.

During the visit, child-to-staff ratios were maintained appropriately.

While on site, the Quality Assurance Monitor verified that incident logs were completed as required when incidents occurred.

During the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed children waking from nap time, engaging in free indoor play, and eating snacks.

A discussion took place between the administrator and the Quality Assurance Monitor regarding several observations made during the visit. The Quality Assurance Monitor noted that children were playing and running in the entrance and hallway areas without supervision. At one point, a child was injured and began crying. The Quality Assurance Monitor reminded the administrator that children must be supervised at all times and emphasized that the entrance and hallway are not designated play areas. Additionally, the Quality Assurance Monitor advised that when children use the washroom, an educator should position themselves to supervise both the washroom and the play area simultaneously. It was also noted that the hallway contains an exit door, posing a potential safety risk if children are unsupervised.

Concerns were also raised regarding snack time procedures. The Quality AssuranceMonitor observed that snacks were laid out on a table for children to access independently, allowing them to prepare their own bowls. While this approach encourages independence, the Quality Assurance Monitor expressed concerns about hygiene and the potential spread of communicable diseases. Specifically, it was observed that a child, while coughing, sat near the communal food and used their personal spoon to serve themselves additional strawberries from the shared bowl. The Quality Assurance Monitor recommended that children eat at a separate table from the displayed food and that an educator be present to supervise the food area. The Quality Assurance Monitor also indicated that these concerns would be shared with Public Health.
