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General Comments Upon licensing staff's arrival for the renewal inspection, children were engaged in multiple areas of play. Children were able to play in the dramatic play area, LEGO and building block area, while another group was observed dancing to music the educator had put on. Children continued to play, with educators joining in or supervising at all times. The educator advised the group that in five minutes it would be time to clean up for an activity. After cleaning up together, the children sat down while the educator explained the activity. As it was "Innovation Week" for the summer camp theme, and the children were already creating with LEGO blocks, the activity consisted of getting into groups and building the highest possible tower that could hold a glue stick for 30 seconds. The children were free to build using whichever materials they wanted within the classroom. The intent of the activity was for the children to think innovatively and tie into the theme of the week. Children who did not want to participate in the activity were provided with the opportunity to read a book. Words of encouragement and positive child guidance was observed throughout the activity. The outdoor environment was checked. Materials available included lacrosse balls and rackets, baseball gloves, hula hoops, chalk, play kitchen materials, soccer balls, basketballs, hockey nets, and a gaga ball area. Staff and child files were reviewed and found to be in compliance. Monthly fire drills are being completed. Licensing recommends the program for renewal.
