Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the children were having morning snack. All children were observed sitting at the tables while they ate. As the children finished eating, they went out to the hallway area with an Educator to get ready for outdoor time. Another Educator stayed in the classroom, sweeping the floors and cleaning the tables while the rest of the children finished their snack. The transition to outdoor time was smooth.  A headcount was performed once the children were ready to go outside. The children lined up and followed the Educator to the fenced in playground. A group of children were seen playing in the kitchen area, using different utensils to scoop the snow. A smaller group of children helped the Educator clear the snow out of the bin of LEGO. Once the school aged children had returned back inside, the preschool class went to play on the larger playground. The children were observed laughing, running and playing on the play structure. Educators were well spread out to ensure supervision was maintained. The transition back inside for lunch was smooth. The children were observed washing their hands before sitting at the tables for lunch.  The classroom offers soft lighting and natural elements such as plants, wooden benches, tree stumps and wooden baskets. The classroom is clean, organized and inviting. There are several large pieces of art displayed that the children created together. Quotes from the children were written on the artwork and pictures of the children creating the piece were printed and displayed as well. There are several current learning stories, family pictures and artwork throughout the classroom. Child guidance was observed during today's visit. Educators were seen offering assistance and comforting children if needed. The Educators praised the children and were heard encouraging their independence, "You did an awesome job, great work!". Staff and child files were reviewed. All files were easily accessible and organize
