General Comments					
Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to perform a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival, the preschool class was in the process of slowly transitioning from quiet time to story time. The environment was calm, with soft music playing. Once all children were awake and napping materials were put away, the children gathered with one Educator who had created a "Storybook Basket". The basket included stories and pictures from their adventures in the woods. The Educator explained they could create a new basket each season. Stories and pictures were laminated and displayed for the children to look through.  In the afterschool class, the Educator was observed greeting and signing in the children as they arrived in the classroom. Hands were washed as the children entered the class. Some children chose to sit and have afternoon snack, while others played board games and built houses using magnetic tiles. Later in the afternoon the Educator was heard letting the children know they had 10 more minutes before it would be time to clean up and go outside. A child in the class had created a song about Little Cubs and all the children in the class. When it was time to clean up, the Educator put the song on. The group was observed singing and dancing along.  The transition outside was smooth. The Educator was observed doing a headcount and updating attendance before walking outside. Families were greeted as the children got picked up and incident logs were signed. Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The Educators were engaged with the children and spoke softly, and kindly towards them.
