General Comments

Upon arrival the children were eating snack. Handwashing was evident and the children were engaged with each other at the table.

The environment is set up with an abundance of material including cars, dinosaurs, a train set, lego, dress up clothes, art materials including paint and playdough. There is also a room set up with books and games and another for a calm or quiet area. The gym or active area has balls, mats, basket ball, hockey sticks and a closet full of a choice of materials for the children to use

The children prepared to go to Deer park. The educators sat them down prior to going, and reminded them of the rules. The children were observed walking 2 by 2 in an organized fashion. The educators were positioned in the front, back and middle. Licensing staff were able to observe the same safety practices when returning to the facility.

The children ate lunch in two groups. One group was in the gym playing games with the educators while the others ate. Licensing staff observed an educator physically showing the children what to do once they were tagged while playing Fishes and Whales. They sat on the floor and waved their arms. The educators remained engaged with the children in all activities for the duration of the visit.

The children also have access to an outdoor area. The area includes planters, a kitchen, basket ball nets, 4 squares game, hockey nets, rackets, skipping ropes, bubbles and seating areas.

The files were more organized than previous visits. Licensing staff advised the administrator that each child including sibling groups require a file of their own. The Operator stated that next summer child profiles and individual files will be used for each child in attendance for camps.

The routine and flow between activities is organized. The educators have clear boundaries set for the children, the children know what to expect which has created a better learning environment for them.

Licensing staff can now recommend facility for licensing.
