General Comments

Upon arrival of licensing staff, the children were divided into three groups. The groups were taking turns playing in the front room, the gym, and outside. The second bus arrived, and the educators greeted the children. The front room had invitations of play set up on tables, such as art, playdoh, books, connect-4, and games. In the gym they were playing "hit the pin" where the children were throwing dodgeballs to hit the bowling pins at the other end of the gym. Outside, some children were having snack, and others were playing with soccer balls and in the kitchen. The educators were observed engaging in conversation with the children and kneeling to their level when talking to them. In the gym, they started a game of "red light, green light" and the children were heard laughing as they played.

The groups would clean up before transitioning to the next room. Some of the children outside took out hockey sticks and started playing mini hockey. Others played tennis, soccer, and imaginary play on the turf. In the gym, they started playing a game of "fruits and vegetables". To get the children's attention, an educator would say "hands on your head" and the children would say "that means stop". The children are familiar with the routine. In the front room, the children were colouring, playing with stickers, and some were reading books with an educator. The educators greeted parents and updated the attendance sheet as the children left.

The indoor environment was clean and organized. Various resources were set up on the tables. Materials are accessible to the children, such as board games, art supplies, books, playdoh, animals, blocks, and train tracks. A discussion was had about doing a walk-through of the outdoor play space as a couple cigarette butts were by the fence. Fire drills are being completed, and the parent board is up to date. Positive child guidance was observed.
