General Comments
<p>Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Today was a PD Day so the children were on site for a full day. The facility was bright, organized and welcoming. The posting board has been updated to reflect the change in Quality Assurance Monitor. The daily schedule was posted on a large whiteboard for all to see. Children were greeted as they arrived this morning and attendance records were updated.</p> <p>Numbers were low today due to the PD Day and there were extra staff on site helping with cleaning and engaging with the children. The indoor environment offered a wide variety of materials for the children such as play doh, crafting materials, building blocks, balls, hockey nets and equipment as well as a large variety of books, board games and puzzles. All play materials were in good condition. A small group of children were observed playing with dinosaurs, trees, plants and safari animals on a train table. Others were observed coloring and building towers with wooden blocks. Later in the morning one Educator asked if anyone would like to go play in the gym. The Educators were observed communicating numbers and doing headcounts before some children transitioned to the gym.</p> <p>The gym was divided into 3 sections. In one section the children were playing with gymnastic mats while the other two sections were setting up to play soccer and hockey. The Educator was observed assisting the children with their hockey gear. The Educators were well spread out in both rooms, ensuring proper supervision was maintained. Several children started asking when lunch time was, the Educators followed their needs and set up tables to have an early lunch. As the children finished eating, they prepared to go outside to play. Tables were sanitized and floors were swept once all children had finished eating. The transition from inside to the outdoor environment was smooth.</p> <p>Only positive child guidance was observed during today's Monitoring Inspection. It is evident the children are familiar with the daily routine and Educators. The Educators were actively engaged in the activities with the children, sitting and coloring with them and playing active games. Weekly and daily cleaning checklists were observed and were up to date. Fire drills and an outdoor maintenance checklist is also being conducted each month.</p>
