Comments: The fire drill for November and December 2025 were not documented. The educator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that the fire drills were completed but the educator forgot to document it. The administrator documented the fire drills while the Quality Assurance Monitor was on site. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments
The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site in the afternoon to conduct a monitoring inspection. The ratio was respected during the monitoring.

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator regarding the address of the medical practitioner and the address of the emergency contact on the children's file. The operator and the administrator are aware and are actively making the change in every child's profile at all locations.

The Quality Assurance Monitor observed the children arriving at the facility from school. The children were observed playing in the outdoor play area, creating multiple snowmen and climbing on snow structures. The children were observed transitioning from the outdoor play area to the indoor play area to eat their afternoon snack (lunch box). Positive interactions were observed between the educators and the children.
