All staff member files must include a copy of a valid first aid certificate and a valid CPR certificate.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor was unable to observe the documentation of the daily activities. The educator shared that the documentation is currently not on-site. The daily activities must be purposefully planned and documented, responding to the capabilities, needs, and interests of each child.

Comments: During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that 1 out of 6 child records reviewed is missing the Medicare number. All child records must include their Medicare numbers.			

<p>General Comments</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is on-site to conduct the renewal inspection.</p> <p>The Quality Assurance Monitor is present in the afternoon during the children's arrival at the facility, snack time, indoor play, and the transition to outdoor play.</p> <p>During the renewal inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed that the monthly emergency evacuation and fire drill were completed for the month of April; however, they had not been completed for the month of March. Monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills must be conducted and documented. The operator shared that the emergency evacuation and fire drills had been conducted in March, but they had forgotten to record the information.</p>

General Comments

A discussion took place with the operator regarding the outdoor play area. The designated area for school-aged children is the community park. Since this park is not part of the daycare, it was not inspected during the renewal inspection. It is the operator's responsibility to ensure that the outdoor play area maintained is safe and free of hazards for children.
