The quality assurance mentor guided the administrator to locate the link. At the time of the inspection, the employee was accompanied by someone who had a valid first aid course. The quality assurance mentor recommends that, until this employee obtains such training, they should be accompanied by a person who has completed the course.</p>			

General Comments
<p>During the monitoring inspection, the following elements were also observed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -The child-to-educator ratio -Criminal record checks / background checks for working with vulnerable persons, valid first aid certificate and valid cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certificate, as well as verification of job descriptions and responsibilities for new staff members -The material and equipment of the indoor play area -The daily routine <p>During the monitoring inspection, the quality assurance monitor observed the following afternoon activities: preparation to go outside, reading the book "Dinosaur", and free play outdoors.</p> <p>There was also observation of craftwork in the shape of a shirt in a preschool room, a Christmas tree with plastic balls in the infant room (the balls were arranged in their own way), snowman footprints painted on the walls (the nose, eyes, and hat were not in the same place), and in another class, a collage of large Christmas lights made of tissue paper glued to the windows. A sensory bin with plastic insects was also observed.</p> <p>The quality assurance monitor answered the questions.</p>
