General Comments

- Visit completed at the facility in the morning for a monitoring inspection.
- During the visit ratio was respected.
- Positive child guidance was witnessed during the visit.
- Outdoor play occurs daily for one hour in each four-hour block of time.
- The daily activities are purposely planned and documented and responds to the needs and interest of each child.
- The parent notifies the facility if the child will be absent and indicates whether the absence is due to illness or otherwise.
- The minimum space between rest equipment is 46 centimeters. All nap equipment is washable and non-absorbent. Rest periods meets individual needs.
- Food brought from home is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated as required. Drinking water is provided throughout the day.
- Individual space is provided for diapers, creams and wipes for each child who is not toilet-trained. Changing area is located one metre or less from a sink. Diaper changing procedures are posted in a visible place in the diaper changing area. Children are always supervised during diaper changing.
- Observations:
- 2-3-year-old group: During the visit free play and outdoor play was witnessed.
- 3-5-year-old room: During the visit the children were creating art, free play and outdoor play was observed. During free play the educator was engaged in the children's play. The children were constructing with blocks and playing with barbies.
- Discussion with the director concerning the support worker who does not have her CPR training. She may not be alone with the child at any time. Visit completed at the facility in the morning for a monitoring inspection.
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- Positive child guidance was witnessed during the visit.
- Outdoor play occurs daily for one hour in each four-hour block of time.
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- Discussion with the director concerning the support worker who does not have her CPR training. She may not be alone with the child at any time. There is a sheduled date for the support worker to complete her CPR training. The director will send me her certificate upon completion of the course.
