General Comments						
Upon Licensing staff arrival, the Operator and children were reading a story together on the couch in the main play space.						
The main play space was clean and contained a wooden play kitchen, a small play climber with a slide, and other wooden play material such as blocks and fine motor skill toys. There was a basket of multicultural dolls, accessible shelves with books, musical instruments, cars, trucks, loose play pieces, and a sensory table with yarn and pipe cleaners. Please be mindful of ripped and torn books, as much as they are enjoyed, they are to be in good condition. Throughout the morning, the children were observed playing with wooden train tracks, cars, and enjoying their reflection in mirrors on the wall. The Operator was actively engaged and offered a soft and caring tone with the children asking questions about their feelings, offered encouragement during play, snuggles, and the opportunity to use their voices and kind words during a small disagreement.  The outdoor play space is large and fully fenced. There were small hockey nets, wooden play pieces, a wagon, balls and a wooden playhouse. During my inspection, a discussion took place with the Operator about additional outdoor winter play ideas. I recommended various snow play activities such frozen snow globes with balloons, and we talked about small snow forts or tunnels for cars. Other ideas could be to use a spray bottle with water and food colouring, use baking pans for snow cakes, or a small ramp for snowball races.  In the main entry way, all required licensing documentation was posted. Once inside, the daily routine, snack menu, photos, a monthly activity plan, and child artwork were posted in visible locations. Monthly fire drills are being completed and recorded. A daily cleaning schedule with check boxes was hanging outside of the nap room and children's belongings were labelled and in bins or on hooks. Also, child and staff files were verified, and all required documentation was in order.  Licensing staff recommends for renewal.
