Comments: At the time of the inspection, the operator was not aware that menu substitutions are to be documented. According to regulation (24)(1)(i), records of menu substitutions and changes must be documented and kept in accordance with regulation 24(2)

Comments: When a communicable disease is going around the facility, the operator informs parents via a facebook group. The operator was not aware that a notice to inform parents of the existence of a communicable disease needed to be posted. Operator must use appendix 13 of the operator's manual and post it in a visible and prominent place in the facility when needed. While QA monitor was on site, the operator printed copies of the appendix 13, and will use them when needed. Deficiency is now compliant							
33(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall complete a monthly review and maintenance plan on all stationary equipment that includes the following information: (a) the review and repair dates; (b) the action required and the action taken; and (c) the name of the staff member who conducted the review.							
Comments: The facility has stationary equipment in the outdoor play area. The operator was unaware that a monthly review and a maintenance plan had to be completed on all stationary equipment. A system allowing operator to complete a monthly review and maintenance plan on stationary equipment must be put in place. The monthly review must be completed on all stationary equipment showing: the review and repair dates; the action required and taken; and the name of the staff completing the review.

The Quality Assurance Monitor verified:

The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the operator regarding the parent board. QA Monitor recommends that all required documents be posted at the entrance of the home, where parents have easy access. They are currently posted in the basement play area, where parents don't usually go. Postings must be visible for parents, preferably on a parent information board at the facility entrance.

A daily incident log is maintained, showing child's name, date, time and record of event and the parent's signature. The incident logs are maintained in the child file. Since the opening of the facility, no reportable incidents occurred. The operator is aware that incident report forms, provided by the Minister, must be documented in the event of reportable incident. The parents of the child must be informed as soon as possible. A copy of the incident report form must be provided to the parent a copy must also be submitted to the department (Quality Assurance Monitor) within 24 hours of occurrence.
